

Repairs with Glue Only

We have found some good glue that works well to repair a broken part from your fountain, birdbath, or statue. The name is Loctite "Quick-Tite".

We do not sell or have any affiliation with this product, so our recommendation is unbiased, however many adhesive products will also work well.



If the part is broken off "cleanly" (meaning it fits back in nicely) it should be an easy fix. Be sure the components are clean and free from any loose particles. A light sanding is always a good idea to "rough it up" a little so it accepts the glue better. Simply apply the glue lightly to each side of the repair.



While this repair may show a small crack, it is still very functional. Other repairs may require some epoxy putty to seal small cracks and fill areas with small holes. Please see our ["making repairs with epoxy putty"](#) page.

The repair below was to the inner twist and lock part, as it was forced on too hard. However, it fit back in well and now works nicely.
